



About Team FMS

Team FMS was formed in 2006 as the official team of Wisconsin based Franklin Motorsports, a division of Dream Works Karting Supply, LLC. Team principals Jamie Sieracki and Jason Matuszewski offer a combined experience of 30 plus years in karting. Their experiences include competitive driving, tuning, data analysis, coaching and race program management. Experience is key in operating a successful race program and their involvement has shown beneficial in various racing efforts

Series Competition

- Team FMS will contest 3 major karting championships in 2010. The season starts with the WKA Manufacturer's Cup championship in Daytona, FL. The Manufacturer's Cup series is their highest level of sprint karting competition. Formed in 1971, the World Karting Association is a membership owned non-profit organization. With over 10,000 active members and 120 sanctioned tracks, WKA is the largest sanctioning body of karting in the US and one of the largest in the world. The Manufacturer's Cup series is a five race series that covers tracks in the Eastern US. Traveling from Florida to Indiana, Wisconsin, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and beyond each season brings a series of five tracks for top level competition.
- The second Championship contested is the rapidly growing Formula Kart Florida Winter tour. The Formula Kart Racing Florida Winter Tour is one of the longest running and largest sprint kart racing series in the world. The 2009 FWT averaged 578 entries per month and featured drivers from 28 different countries, 28 U.S. States and 5 Canadian Provinces. Holding 6 races between January and March, the Florida Winter Tour has evolved from a winter tune up series to a full fledged championship series. The FWT is divided into 2 series, one focusing on Rotax categories and the other focusing on TaG & CIK categories.
- The third series of competition for Team FMS is the CKI National series. Covering the country from east to west the CKI offers a full 6 race national schedule as the top level of karting. Drivers compete in a limited number of classes to crown a year end national champion in each category. The locations allow for a true national champion as competitors from around the US can compete against one another. With a WKA-sanctioned national race series starting in 2009, Championship Karting International has been founded with a mission: Wanting more than a kart racing series, our founders are absolutely committed to using the kart racing arena to train the Motorsports champions of tomorrow.

- With these series chosen, Team FMS offers a variety of competition formats. Additional events will become available as schedules are released.

Team Goals

The goal of Team FMS is to provide a professional environment for members and their families/patrons. Each series program provides members with a transport and storage program for equipment to each series event. Pitting is also arranged for all the drivers involved with the Team FMS program. Pit spots are secured as well as professional team tents set-up for event duration. The amenities for the 2010 program will include an individual work space as well as required equipment to assist in tuning. All events will have a Team FMS staff member dedicated to group help. The staff member is responsible for assisting all members in tuning and coaching as well as parts distribution from an on-board inventory. Pricing is based on participant numbers which will be capped at 5 team drivers. Members must commit to all races in their chosen series. Requirements include wearing team apparel to assist in a top level image. Apparel packages will be available before the first event and can be customized for each participant's individual sponsors.

Pricing Structure
